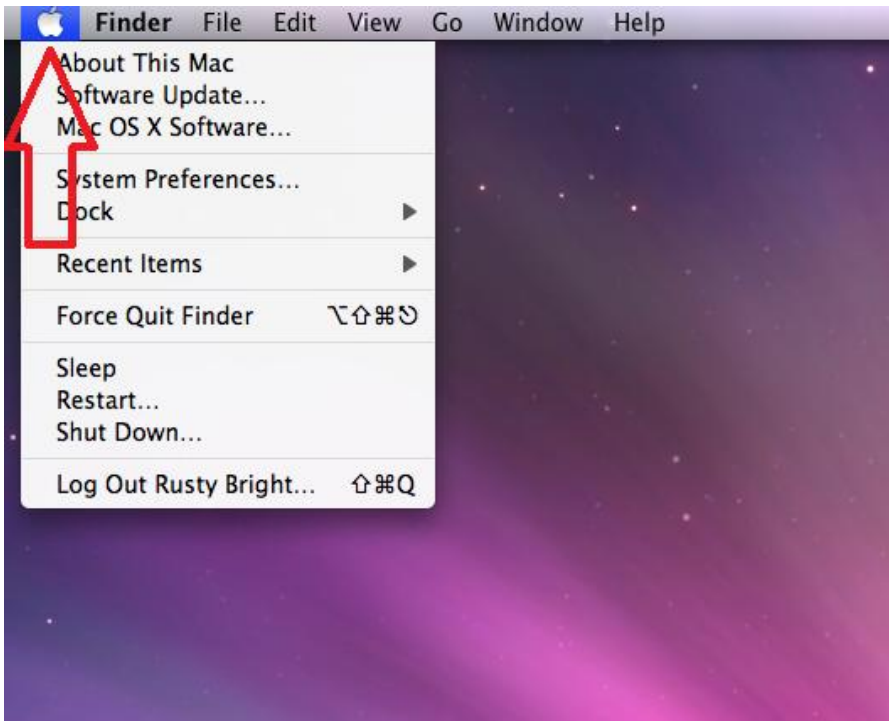

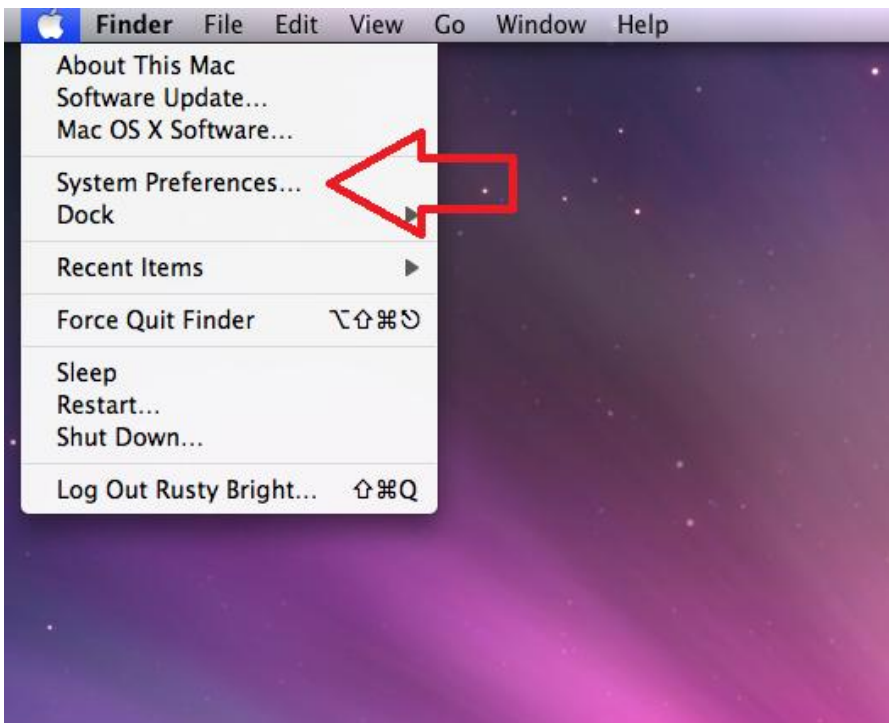

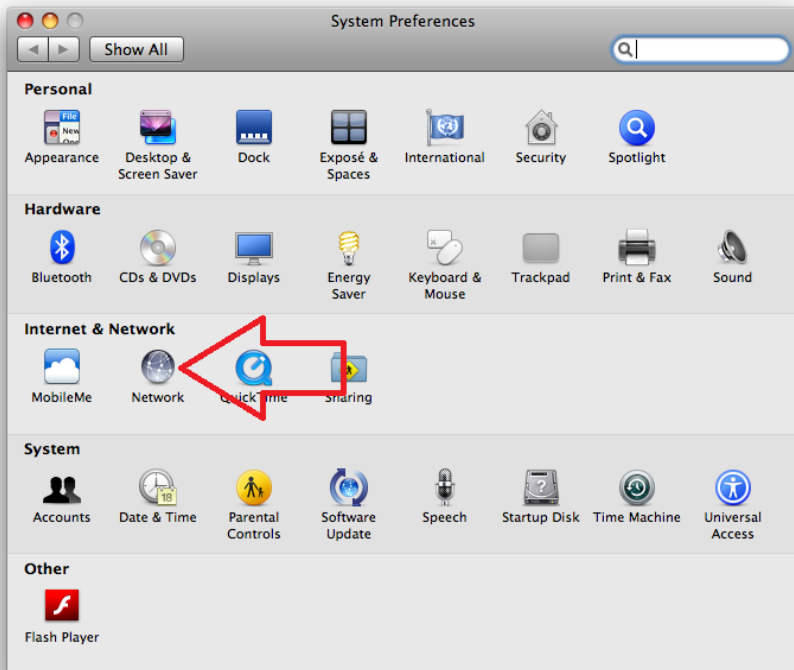
Click on the Apple Logo



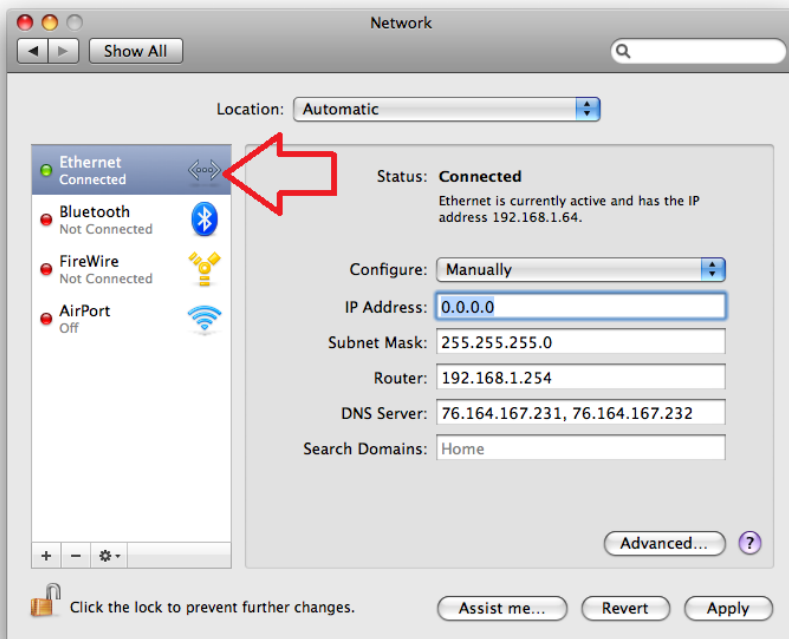
Then click on 'System Preferences...'



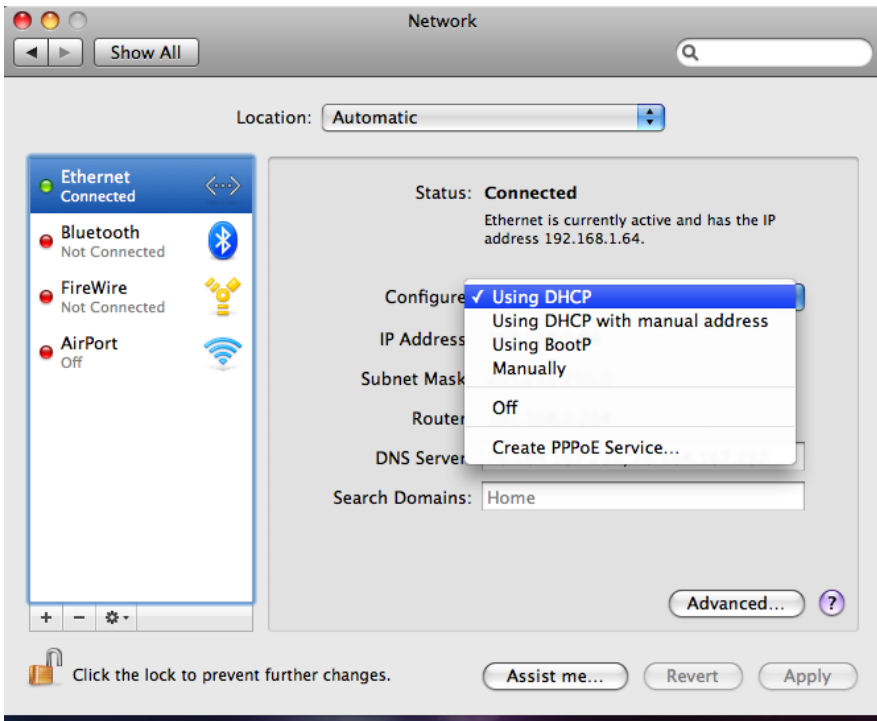
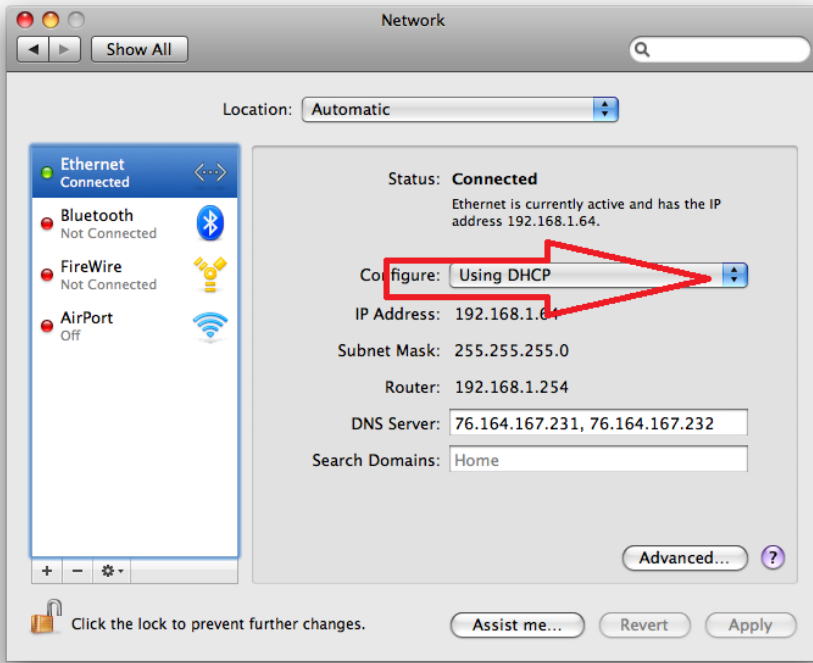
This opens the System Preferences window, click on the 'Network' icon



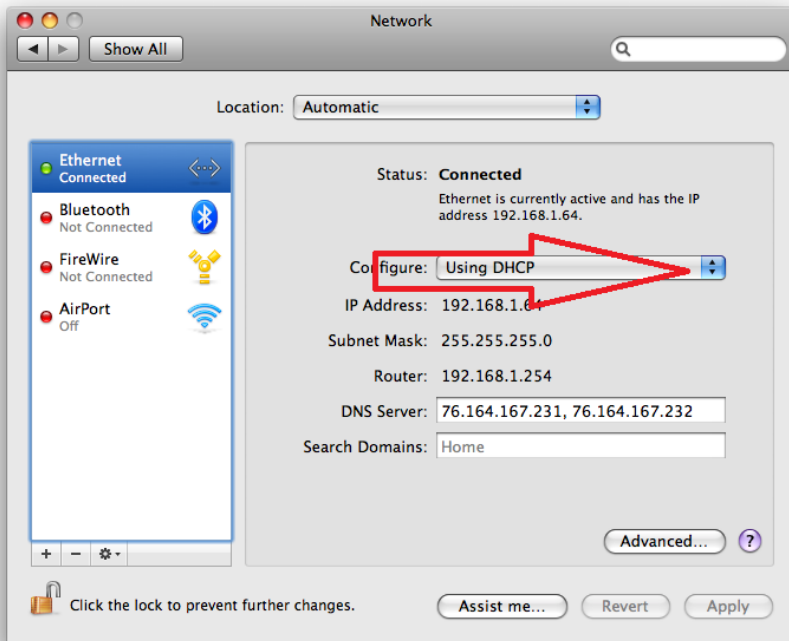
Click on 'Ethernet' on the left side
