Ham & Cheese Pasta Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups uncooked elbow macaroni (or pasta of choice)
- 2 Tablespoons white vinegar
- 2 cups chopped cooked ham
- 1 (12 oz) package frozen peas, thawed
- 1 (8 oz) block mild or medium cheddar cheese, cut in small cubes
- ½ cup very finely chopped onion

DRESSING:

- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 Tablespoon white vinegar
- 1 Teaspoon granulated sugar
- ½ Teaspoon salt
- ¼ Teaspoon pepper

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cook macaroni (pasta) in boiling salted water according to package directions. Drain well. Place warm pasta in a large bowl and toss with 2 Tablespoons vinegar. Stir in cubed cheese, ham, peas, and onion. Set aside to let noodles absorb the vinegar. Prepare dressing in a separate smaller bowl: whisk together mayonnaise, 1 Tablespoon vinegar, sugar, salt, and pepper. Pour over the pasta mixture and stir until well combined. Cover and chill for at least an hour before serving. Or chill overnight to allow the flavors to fully marinate.



Sour Cream Pancakes

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup sour cream
- 7 Tablespoons flour
- 2 Tablespoons sugar
- 1 Teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 large eggs
- ½ Teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 Teaspoon butter to cook pancakes with (optional – more butter for serving)
- Warm syrup to serve with pancakes

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Whisk the eggs and vanilla together in a small bowl, set aside. Using another small bowl, whisk together the flour, sugar, baking soda and salt. Set aside. Place the sour cream

- in a medium bowl, add the flour mixture and whisk until just combined, don't overmix. Whisk in the eggs and vanilla until just incorporated. Heat a skillet on low to medium heat. Place 1 Teaspoon of butter in the skillet, swirl the butter around to coat the pan. Pour the batter in the skillet by quarter cups. Cook until bubbles start to form on the surface and the edges start to brown. Flip the pancakes and cook for an additional minute. When the pancakes are done, they will be a little soft. Serve with butter and syrup.
